For ten years he has been a member of the board of directors and currently chairs the Quality Subcommittee for St. Christopher’s Hospital for Children in Philadelphia. He is a member of the Development Committee of the Institute for Healthcare Improvement headquartered in Cambridge MA. He also supports pediatric heart research and HIV/AIDS patient care initiatives through the Brad Hayman Foundation. For many years, Hayman managed banking groups which provided credit facilities and transactional services to healthcare providers and insurers, allowing them to expand their services and achieve operating efficiencies.

That combination is just what our fast-growing company, devoted to exceptional primary care for its patients, requires at this time”, stated Knowlton.
